

# Cricket Creek Forest Preserve Addison

## Location

The main entrance is on the north side of Fullerton Avenue. A second entrance is on Frontage Road south of Krage Drive.

## Preserve Features

- Access to Salt Creek from canoe launch off Fullerton
- Nearly 2 miles of flat crushed-limestone trails
- Wetland mitigation restoration area in northern section
- Paved trail around picnic area
- Lake, creek and ponds for ample fishing

## Please Be Aware

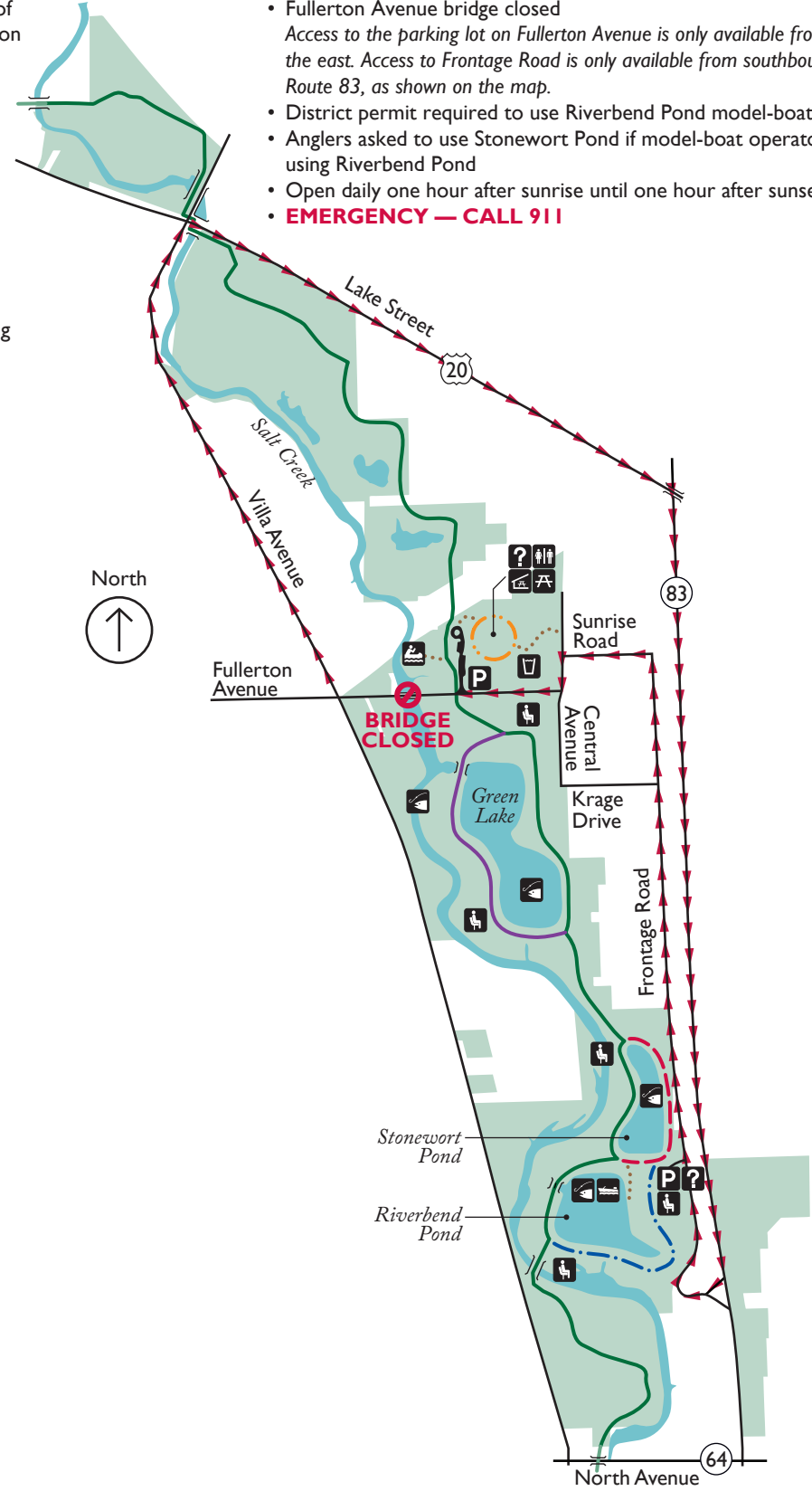
- Fullerton Avenue bridge closed  
Access to the parking lot on Fullerton Avenue is only available from the east. Access to Frontage Road is only available from southbound Route 83, as shown on the map.
- District permit required to use Riverbend Pond model-boating area
- Anglers asked to use Stonewort Pond if model-boat operators are using Riverbend Pond
- Open daily one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset
