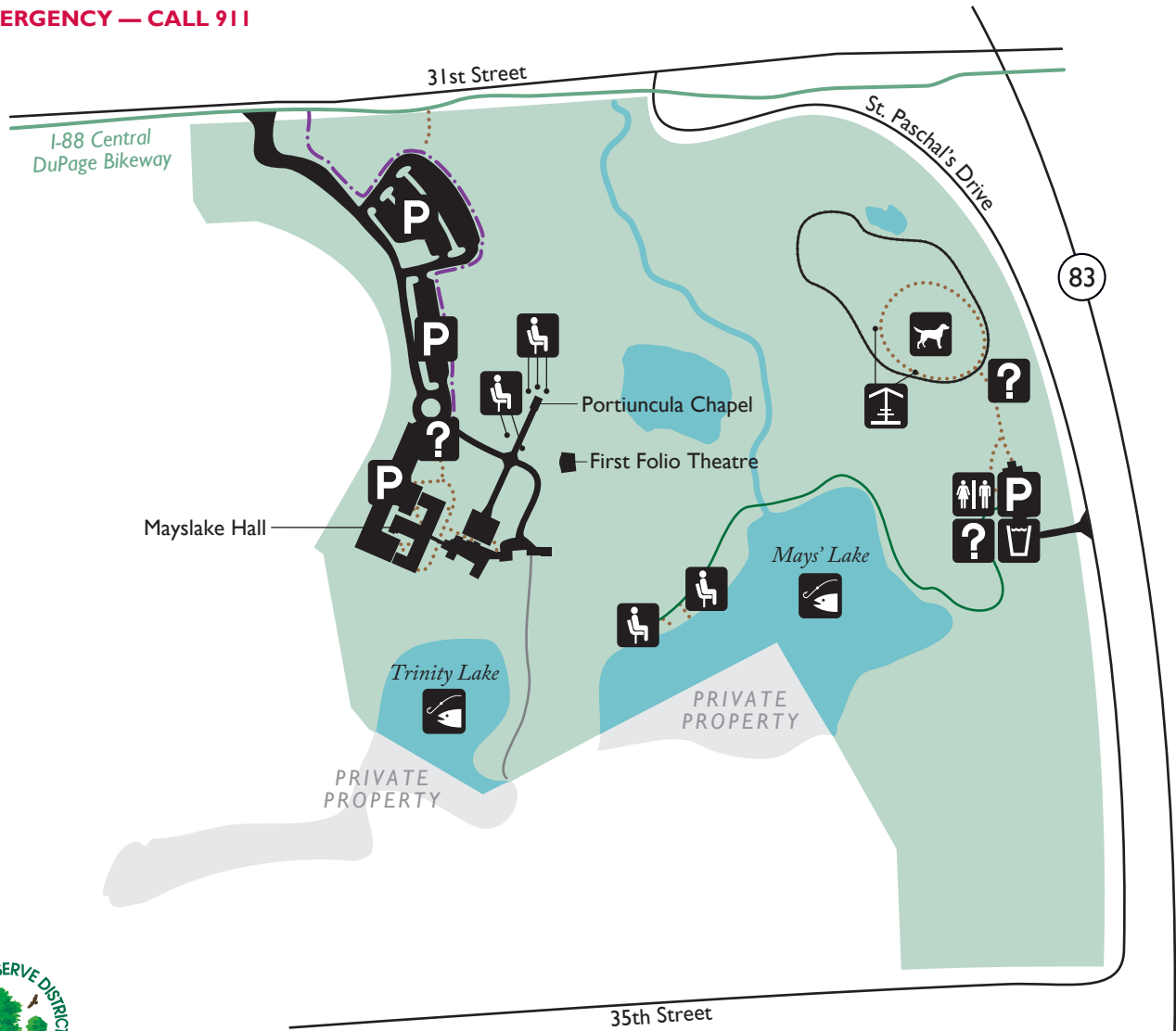
Preserve Features

- 87-acre preserve
- Historic Mayslake Peabody Estate with Mayslake Hall, the Portiuncula Chapel and the First Folio Theatre outdoor stage
- 3 acres of fishing on Trinity Lake and 8 acres of fishing on Mays' Lake with largemouth bass, bluegill, catfish and crappie

- Sections of Trinity and Mays' lakes on private property
- Open daily one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset
