

McDowell Grove Forest Preserve Naperville

Location

The entrance is on the east side of Raymond Drive at McDowell Road 0.6 mile south of I-88 and 1.2 miles north of Ogden Avenue (Route 34).

Preserve Features

- Mature woodlands, open fields, West Branch of the DuPage River
- Access to fishing on shores of Mud Lake and West Branch of the DuPage River
- Civilian Conservation Corps-built shelter
- Put-in and take-out river access for paddlers at McDowell Grove at Fawell Dam
