

Pratt's Wayne Woods Forest Preserve Wayne

Location

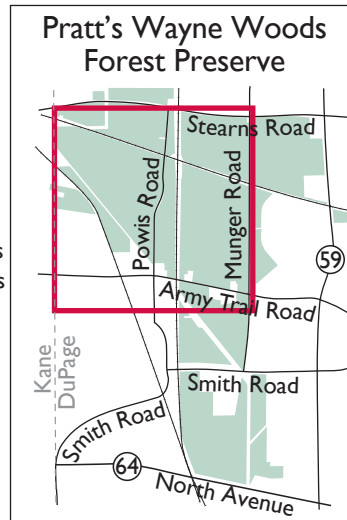
Entrances are on Powis Road 0.7 mile north of Army Trail Road and 0.9 mile south of Stearns Road.

Preserve Features

- Connects to Elgin Branch of Illinois Prairie Path
- Audubon Important Bird Area — globally significant habitat for conservation of bird populations
- Wetlands — great blue herons, sandhill cranes, beavers, hawks
- Savanna — oaks, pale-leaved sunflowers, smooth yellow violets
- Two wheelchair-accessible fishing piers on Pickerel Lake

Please Be Aware

- Horse-trailer parking at gravel lot east of Powis only
- Heavy equestrian traffic
- Valid District permits required to use off-leash dog area and model-airplane field
- Open daily one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset

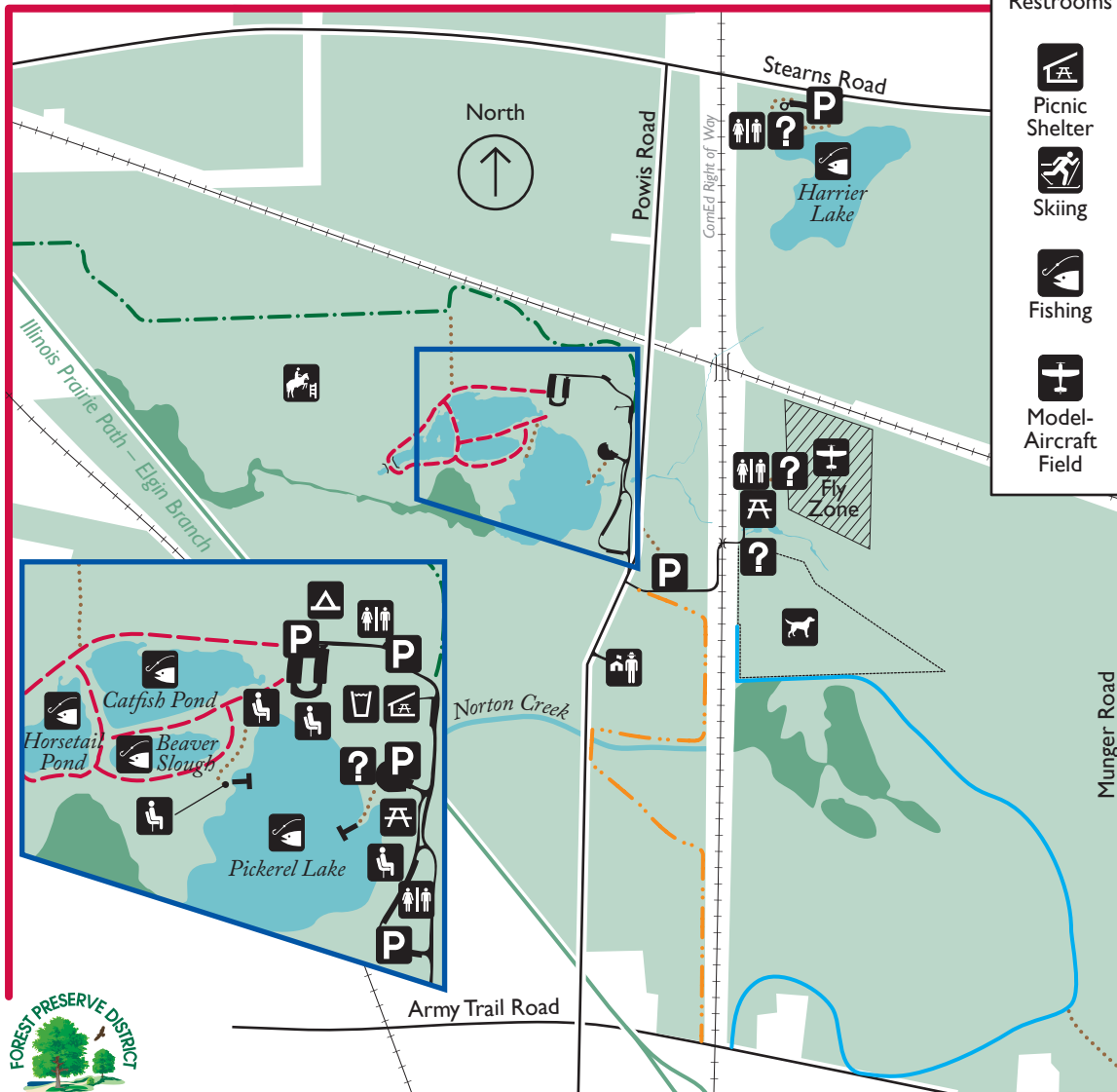


Trail Distances
