

Wood Dale Grove Forest Preserve Wood Dale

Location

The entrance is located on the east side of Wood Dale Road 0.5 mile north of Lake Street (Route 20) and 0.25 mile south of 3rd Avenue (Oak Meadows Drive).

- Open daily one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset

Preserve Features

- Trail around Grove Lake north into upland savanna — jack-in-the-pulpits, spring beauties, rue anemones, trout lilies, red trilliums, benches to enjoy spectacular spring wildflowers
- Avian migrants — yellow-rumped warblers, ruby-crowned kinglets
- Nesting area for hooded warblers, black-cuckoos, blue-gray gnatcatchers
- Great 20-minute lunchtime loop around lake
- Two wheelchair-accessible fishing piers



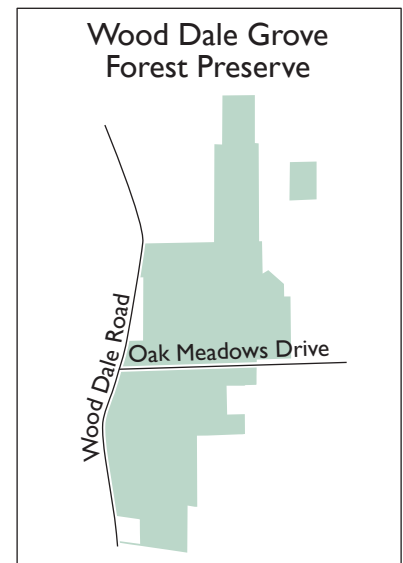
Trail Distances
